Visits ATHARVA Campus.



Honourable Shri Nitin Gadkariji, Union Minister of Road Transport and Highway and Shipping graced the Foundation Stone laying ceremony and the **Bhoomi Pujan of Atharva IT Park** on the 1st of April 2016.

A seminar on –“**National Growth Through Infrastructure Development**” was held in the auditorium of Atharva campus on the same day i.e the 1st of April 2016. This event was presided over by Honourable Executive President of Atharva Group Of Institutes- Shri Sunilji Rane. The Chief Guest for this program was honourable Union Minister for roads and transport and highways Shri Nitin Gadkariji.

The other dignitaries who graced this event were- Honourable Shri Dattaji Rane- Ex Higher and Technical Education Minister, Member

of Parliament - Shri Gopal Shettyji, MLA- Shri Yogesh Sagarji, Municipal Councillors- Shri Ram Barotji and Shri Vinod Shelarji. The guests of honour for this program were Dr. Abhay Wagh (Director of Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai) and Commander Dipak Naik (President, Maharashtra Economic Developmental Council). Several corporate officials attended this seminar along with the Dean, Principals, Faculty members and students of Atharva Group Of Institutes.

Nitin Gadkariji, highlighted his speech on, National growth through infrastructure development. Some key points to note were- He emphasized on more technological innovations focusing on economic viability and reduction of costs. He expressed his keen interests in water management, waste management and solar energy projects. His ministry is working with ISRO to develop lithium-ion-battery for use in vehicles contributing to “Make In India” campaign. He narrated his Nagpur experiences and his plan to promote use of ethanol, bio-diesel and ethanol blended fuel. The focus is on rural and urban development and generating more employment opportunities through entrepreneurship. He also spoke of promoting tourism in Maharashtra and throughout the country through infrastructure development, for example construction of a road linking Manasarovar in Himalayas to Uttarakhand directly avoiding the passage through Nepal & China has already begun. He has developed Mumbai Pune Expressway in a record time of 2 years and couple of dozens of flyover bridges in Mumbai to control traffic congestion. He also enlightened the audience about the marine sector and how all the ports in India have improved on their cargo handling operations. He expressed his ambitious plans of increasing rate of road construction, modernization of ports , islands , setting up new major ports, coastal economic zones and developing fisheries

The seminar was indeed enlightening and enriching with lots of ideas and thoughts to ponder upon for the audience. It was indeed a very memorable day for all ATHARVITES!!!

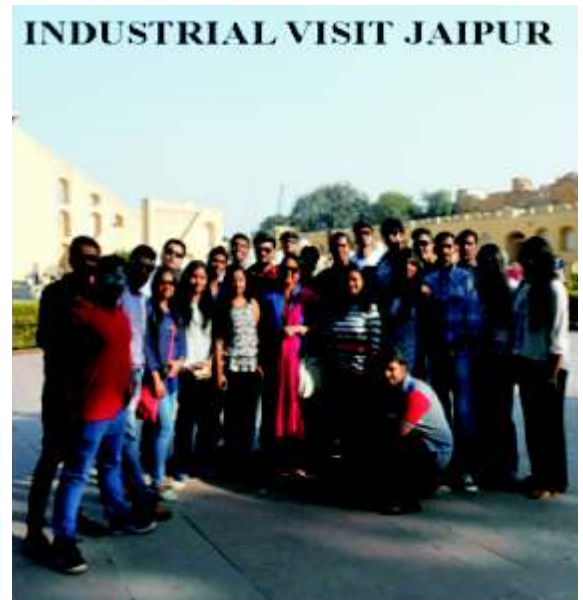
INDUSTRIAL VISIT JAIPUR

CHEESE ALL THE WAY INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO GOVARDHAN CHEESE FARM

Cheese is definitely popular and preferred by most people young and old.

So, would You want to understand how one of the biggest Cheese Factory produces this famous product Cheese? The answer being YES!

All the streams of Atharva College of Hotel Management, students visited the " Govardhan Cheese Factory" in the Manchar District of Pune over the spread of three days.

Industrial visit to the Govardhan Cheese Farm took place on 02/12/2015, 03/12/2015 and 04/12/2015.

Hotel Management Students accompanied by Faculties, left for Pune in the wee hours of the morning to see first hand the operations of the Cheese Factory.

Before we read about how was their day and what did they do, let us understand a little bit more about "Cheese"..

HISTORY OF CHEESE

It is believed that Cheese originated simply by accident.

Milk was transported in the bladders made of Ruminants.

(Ruminants - what are they? Ruminants are Mammals that are able to acquire nutrients fro plant based foods by fermenting it in their stomachs prior to digestion. Ruminant animals are - for example, cattle, goats, sheep, giraffe, yaks, deer, antelopes, to name a few)

The stomachs of these animals had "Rennet" in them that transforms Milk into Cheese.
And hence Cheese was discovered, all by accident.

Animal skins and inflated internal organs were used, in the ancient times, as storage vessels for a wide range of food stuffs. Hence since the milk was stored in the bladders of the ruminants, fortunately for us Cheese was thus discovered.

We spoke about the word " Rennet ", so, what is it?

RENNET is complex enzymes produced in the stomachs of ruminant animals. Chymosin is the key component which is an enzyme that curdles the milk.

The Govardhan Cheese Factory at Manchar Pune, with a production capacity of 40 MT (metric tonnes), is one of the only two facilities in Asia UHT (ultra heat treatment) Technology. The equipment, imported from Stephan Machinery Germany, pioneers in cheese processing equipment, allows the UHT treated cheese to be stored in an ambient condition without refrigeration up to a period of six months in tropical countries like India.

The itenary of the Industrial Visit as planned included, departing from Mumbai and arriving at Factory/Plant by 11.00am. On arrival everyone proceeded for the Video Presentation and Introduction of the Product.

AT 12.00 noon, buffet lunch was served at a Pure Vegetarian Restaurant.

After lunch they visited the Bhagyalaxmi Cow Farm - the Cow's farm where one can experience the unique Cow Milking Process which is India's first Rotary Milk process and Automatic milking of more than 3000 cow's at a time with an amazing discipline.

After the cow's farm visit the Asia's biggest Cheese plant our students enjoyed live experience in the making of milk products.

The students also enjoyed Tea and snacks being part of the tour.

All, the Faculties and Hotel Management students departed back for Mumbai with memorable Experience of the Govardhan Cheese Factory Industrial Visit....

Project - 'e-SewaSuvidha' a Website created in ASP.NET - MVC

As part of my final year curriculum my team mates and I have created a Website 'e-SewaSuvidha'.

e-SewaSuvidha offers the convenience of online accesses to all citizens effectively ending the digital divide. You can use our innovative process and extensive infrastructure and obtain these services close to home. This website is created in MVC.

What is MVC?

MVC is one of three ASP.NET programming models.

MVC is a framework for building web applications using a MVC (Model View Controller) design:

- The Model represents the application core (for instance a list of database records).
- The View displays the data (the database records).
- The Controller handles the input (to the database records).

The MVC model also provides full control over HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.



The MVC model defines web applications with 3 logic layers:
The business layer (Model logic)
The display layer (View logic)
The input control (Controller logic)

The Model is the part of the application that handles the logic for the application data. Often model objects retrieve data (and store data) from a database.

The View is the parts of the application that handles the display of the data. Most often the views are created from the model data.

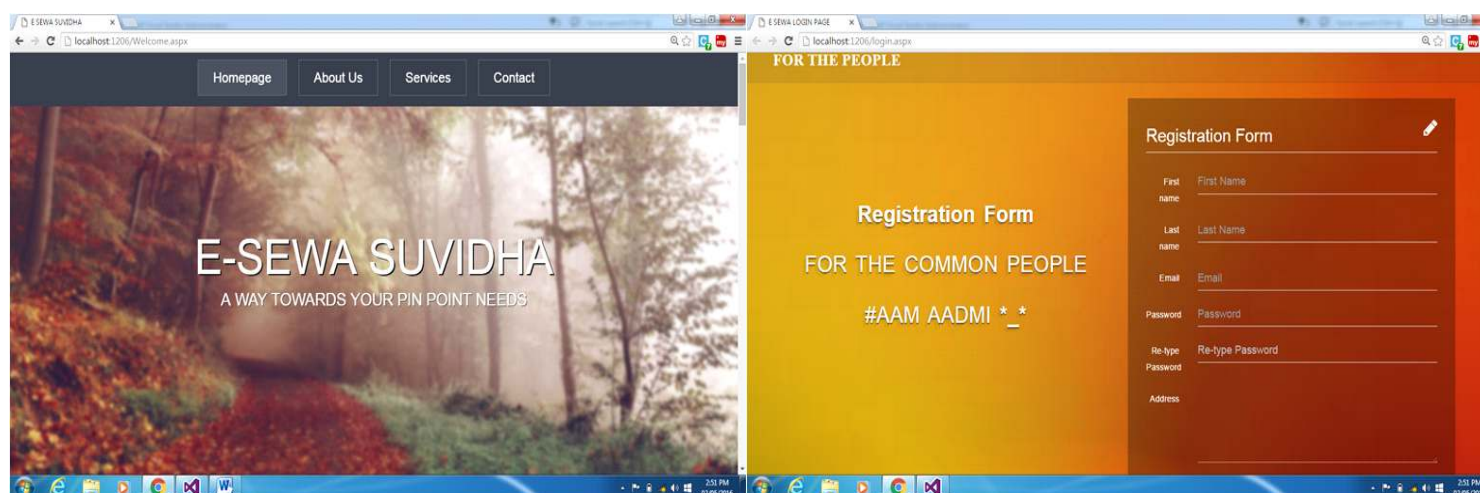
The Controller is the part of the application that handles user interaction. Typically controllers read data from a view, control user input, and send input data to the model. The MVC separation helps you manage complex applications, because you can focus on one aspect a time. For example, you can focus on the view without depending on the business logic. It also makes it easier to test an application.

The MVC separation also simplifies group development. Different developers can work on the view, the controller logic, and the business logic in parallel.

Web Forms vs MVC

The MVC programming model is a lighter alternative to traditional ASP.NET (Web Forms). It is a lightweight, highly testable framework, integrated with all existing ASP.NET features, such as Master Pages, Security, and Authentication.
