DESCRIPTION

- To foster interdepartmental collaboration and holistic development in curriculum design.
- To enhance overall faculty development through reflective discussion and mutual learning.

Key Takeaways: Cross-Functional Relevance: It was widely recognized that many management concepts are interlinked. For instance, HR strategies significantly impact operations and marketing outcomes.

Pedagogical Tools: Introduction to simulation tools and gamification methods used in Finance and Marketing to boost student involvement.

Case-Based Learning: The effectiveness of real-world case studies across disciplines was highlighted, with Finance and Strategy faculties recommending collaborative case development.

Learning Outcomes:

Broadened **Perspective:** Faculties appreciated learning how topics in other domains can be integrated into their own teaching to give students a broader managerial understanding.

Collaborative **Curriculum Design:** The session encouraged faculties to work together in creating interdisciplinary modules.

Student-Centric Learning: There was a mutual agreement on shifting focus from teacher-led lectures to interactive, experiential learning environments.

Continuous **Improvement:** The need for regular peer learning sessions for continuous improvement and innovation in teaching was acknowledged.
