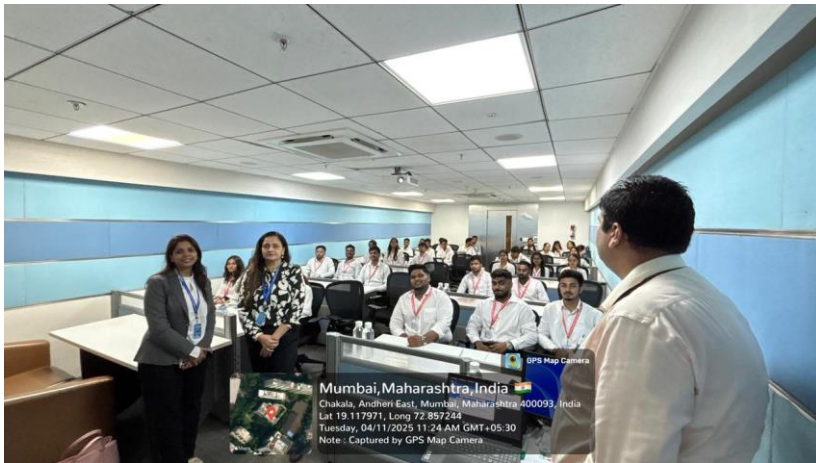

The session also helped improve communication, curiosity, and participation among students.






















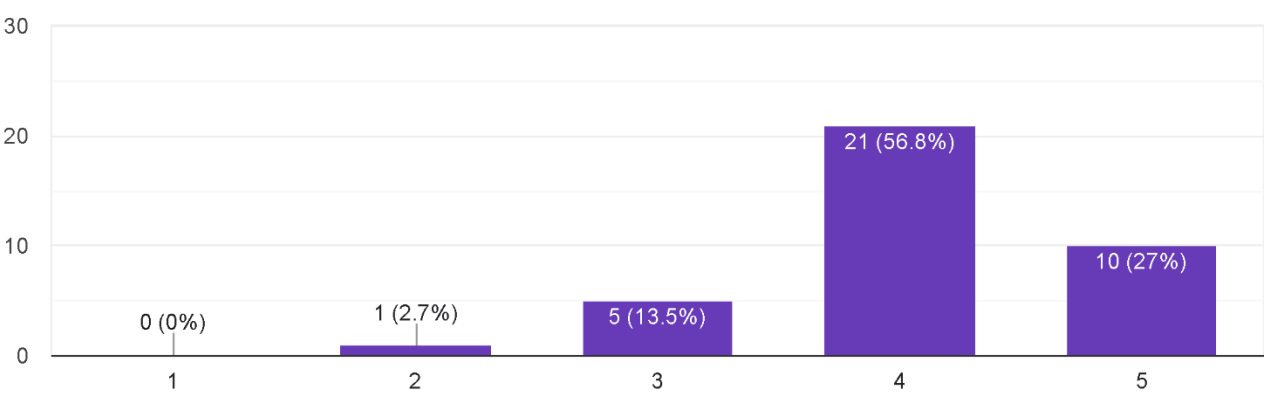
3. How would you rate the overall session conducted at MCX?

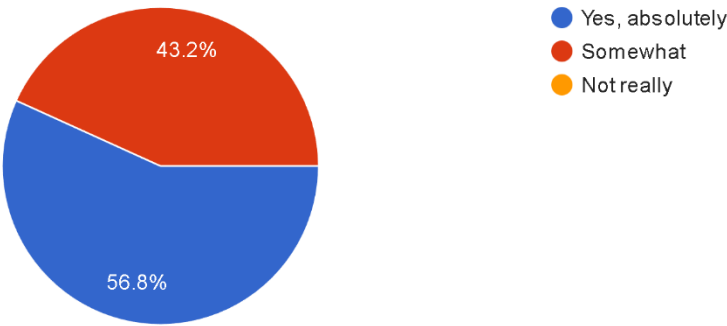
4. How engaging and interactive was the speaker during the session?

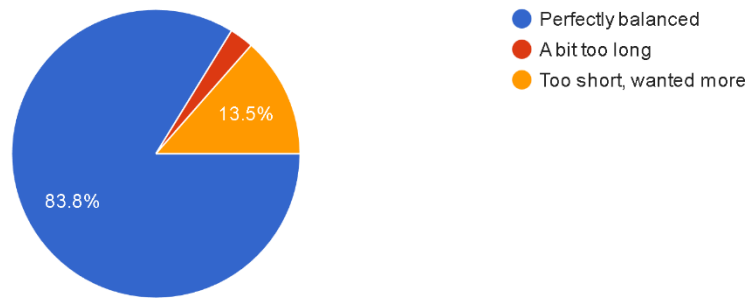
5. Did you find the content of the session relevant to your course or career interests?

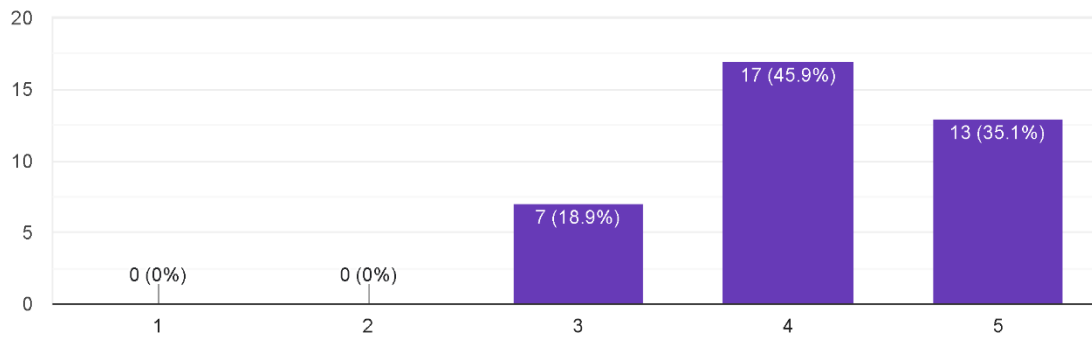
7. How well was the duration (45 minutes) managed?

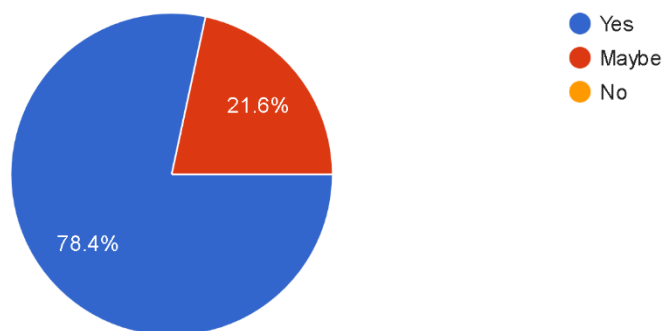
8. How would you rate the overall organization of the MCX visit?
